PUBLIC NOTICE NO. 12/2026-27

Subject: Pan-India implementation of the Sea Cargo Manifest and Transhipment Regulations (SCMTR), 2018 – reg.

In pursuance of **CBIC Circular No. 29/2026-Customs dated 01.07.2026**, this Public Notice is issued to facilitate the smooth implementation of the Sea Cargo Manifest and Transhipment Regulations (SCMTR), 2018 at Custom House, Mundra.

2. Attention of all Shipping Lines, Shipping Agents, Authorised Sea Carriers, Authorised Sea Agents, Authorised Carriers, Terminal Operators, Custodians, Customs Brokers, Importers, Exporters and other stakeholders is invited to the provisions of the Sea Cargo Manifest and Transhipment Regulations, 2018 issued vide Notification No. 38/2018-Customs (N.T.) dated 11.05.2018, as amended from time to time.

3. The Board has informed that all SCMTR messages, except Import Transhipment (ITP) messages, have been implemented on a Pan-India basis with effect from **01.07.2026**. Accordingly, all stakeholders shall ensure timely and accurate electronic filing of the prescribed SCMTR messages in accordance with the Customs Act, 1962 and SCMTR, 2018.

4. Further, the transitional provisions under SCMTR, 2018 have been extended up to **31.08.2026** vide Notification No. 61/2026-Customs (N.T.) dated 01.07.2026. During this period, stakeholders shall electronically file all prescribed SCMTR messages (except ITP messages) in the prescribed manner.

5. In addition to above, to facilitate trade, no penal action shall be initiated against stakeholders for technical or procedural difficulties faced in online filing under SCMTR upto 31.08.2026.

6. Fortnightly outreach/sensitisation sessions will be conducted to identify and resolve difficulties faced by stakeholders in the implementation of SCMTR messages. Stakeholders are advised to actively participate in such sessions and bring specific technical or procedural issues to the notice of the concerned officers for timely resolution.

7. Any difficulty faced in implementation of the SCMTR module may be brought to the notice of the Assistant Commissioner (MCD), Custom House, Mundra for necessary assistance.
