Subject: Conduct of online examination under Regulation 6 of Customs Brokers Licensing Regulations, 2018 by the National Academy of Customs, Indirect Taxes and Narcotics (NACIN), Palasamudram – reg.

The written examination of Customs Brokers Licensing Examination, for the **Year 2027**, shall be conducted by NACIN in March 2027 at the designated examination centers across India.

2. The complete “F Category Exam & License” applications are to be submitted to the Policy Section of Customs Commissionerate) having jurisdiction over the area where the applicant intends to carry business along with the prescribed fee of ₹ 500/- (Rupees five hundred only) either online in the “F Category Exam & License” application form or through manual challan at the Policy Section only in online mode on the CBLMS Portal (<https://cblms.gov.in>) from 14.10.2026 to 13.11. 2026 up to 2400 Hrs. Applications sent by post will not be entertained.

3. The online written examination will be a Computer Based Exam with Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of **two and half hours (10:30 Hrs to 13:00 Hrs)** duration. Questions will be bilingual i.e. in English and Hindi. The pattern of the examination will be as follows:

No. of questions: 150

Marking scheme: +3 for each correct answer

-1 for each incorrect answer

Maximum marks: 450

Qualifying marks: **270 (60%)**

4. The syllabus of examination is prescribed in Regulation 6 (7) of the Customs Brokers Licensing Regulations, 2018, as amended. Those

qualifying in the said examination will have to appear for oral examination in terms of Regulation 6 of the said Regulations.

5. The oral examination will be held during the second quarter of the calendar year 2027. **The pass percentage marks for qualifying in the oral examination will be 60%.**

6 . Attention is invited to the Guidelines dated 29.08.2018 issued by Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) and circulated by CBIC vide letter dated 10.10.2018 pertaining to the persons with benchmark disability. It is hereby advised that eligible candidates meeting these criteria of benchmark disability and willing to avail the benefit of these guidelines should appropriately intimate about their eligibility, and willingness so that necessary arrangements can be made by the exam conducting authority and its partner agencies.

7 . A dummy question paper for the purpose of awareness of candidates will be made available on the NACIN website www.nacin.gov.in under **Examination → Customs Broker → Practice Test** from **February 2027**. A link for downloading the admit card shall also be made available under the said tab. An intimation regarding the availability of the admit card shall additionally be sent by e-mail to eligible candidates **at least 12 days prior to the date of examination**. For the convenience of candidates, other relevant information, including the list of examination centres, instructions/guidelines for candidates, help-desk details, email ID and other necessary instructions, shall also be made available under the said tab.
