Subject: Request to make one G-Card valid in all Customs Commissionerates:

On the above cited subject, kind reference is invited towards your letter F. No. 520/07/2013-Cus. VI (Vol. III) dated 21.03.2023 and reminder email dated 05.06.2023, wherein it has been requested to examine the issues raised in the representations and provide inputs/comments on the same.

2. In this connection, inputs / comments on the points mentioned in the above letter are as under :

- The suggestion for making G- Card valid to function at any Customs location on behalf of his/her employer CB/CHA at all Customs Commissionerates in India may be considered subject to the condition that CB has duly obtained permission to work in that jurisdiction. Conducting a common examination at all-India level for issuance of G card may also be considered as a step in this direction.
- The suggestion may be considered only in respect of such 'G' card holders, for which Customs Broker is having permission to work in all Indian Ports (Cargo Clearance) and Sea Ports (Cargo Depot)
- After implementation of CBLMS portal, process of issuance of 'F', 'G' and 'H' cards has already been made completely online.
- After implementation of CBLMS portal, facility to view 'F', 'G' and 'H' cards by scanning QR code has already been made online.
- NOC from present Customs Broker should not be made mandatory since it might make such 'G' card holders being prone to exploitation by the present Customs Broker.
